Tastes of Danube: Bread connects

Bread is more than a basic food. For many centuries, it has been a symbol for community and sharing in almost every culture and religion in Europe. Since bread connects us in so many ways, we have named our project "Bread connects".

Goals

In the project "Tastes of Danube. Bread connects" bread shall be experienced as a **culturally specific and identity-sustaining measure** for different target groups in the Danube area: With common cross-border work, one can find cultural distinctiveness, differences, but also many similarities — diversity is experienced positively through communal action. The long-term goal is to create a virtual "Cultural Road of Bread along the Danube" based on the results of the project.

Methods

Apart from researching baking traditions, festivities and museums, the focus is on researching public baking houses as a way of common baking and communication.

Through intergenerational, intercultural and inclusive baking activities as well as qualification for new methods for baking as an identity-generating activity, bread as cultural good is experienced in its diversity on a local, national and European level.
